#### **RULES**



- The competition is open to all high school students living in the 34<sup>th</sup> Congressional District.
- Entry must be of original concept, design, and execution and may not violate any U.S. Copyright Laws. Only one entry per student will be accepted.
- Entry must not reproduce an existing photo, painting, graphic, advertisement or any work produced by another person.
- The work may not infringe the rights of any third party.
- Framed or matted entries will not be accepted.

#### **ENTRIES AND GUIDELINES**

- Artwork must be two-dimensional, no larger than 26 inches by 26 inches.
- The following mediums can be used individually or in combination: paintings, drawings, prints, film or digital photography, and computer generated art.
- Photography may not be smaller than 8 inches by 10 inches.
- The winning entry will represent the 34<sup>th</sup> Congressional District and be displayed in the U.S. Capitol for one year in a national exhibition.
- Top entries will be displayed in Congresswoman Lucille Roybal-Allard's District Office for one year.
- Entries will be framed and displayed in a month-long exhibit.
